



Standard Operating Procedures & Code of Conduct

Requirements

- Applicants must be 14-20 years of age and have completed the 8th grade
- Must complete all paperwork prior to interview
- Must have clear background check
- Must report any contact with law enforcement
- Must want to learn and have FUN!!

Interview

- All new Applicants are required to go through a post sponsored interview
- During Applicants interview: at least one SCFD Advisor will be present along with the Explorer Captain and/or Explorer Lieutenant's
- Interview will last about 15 minutes

Probation Period

- All Applicants that complete their proper paperwork and complete their interview will become Probationary Explorers
- Probation will last 6 months from date of first meeting
- Probationary Explorers are allowed to be involved in any event the post is a part of (except Ride-A-Longs)
- Probationary Explorers can be removed early from Probation if they show their ability to attend meeting, and show their ability to listen and be a leader
- Probationary Explorers must also attend at least 50% of post meeting and post events
- Once a Probationary Explorer has completed their Probation they will be promoted to Explorer will the ability to take part in Ride-A-Longs





<u>Meetings</u>

- Explorer meetings are held every 1st and 3rd Tuesday of the month.
- Attendance will be taken at every meeting by the Post Captain and/or Post Lieutenant
- If you are unable to attended a meeting contact the Post Captain at least 24 hours in advance
- Meeting will last from 6:30pm- 9pm
- Unless otherwise noted all meeting will take place at Station 2
- Explorers are required to wear a Post 4011 T-Shirt, Navy EMS Pants, and Closed Toe Boots or Shoes
- While in ANY SCFD building you must act professional at all times
- If Tones go off in Station remain silent for the entire transmission
- Be prepared for Explorer meetings (have chapter read for class and be prepared for test at end of class)
- Bring fire book to all post meetings

Ride-A-Longs

- All Explorers who have completed probation will have the opportunity to take part in 2 Ride-A-Longs
- Ride-A-Longs last from 8am-8pm
- Must attend 50% of Explorer meetings
- Must score at least 70% over all on fire quizzes
- Explorers are required to wear a Post 4011 T-Shirt, Navy EMS Pants, and Black Boots. (No exceptions.) NO HATS
- Explorers are not for any reason to enter a hazardous environment until deemed safe by a Fire Officer
- Explorers must follow all directions at all times; Free lancing will not be tolerated
- Explorers may assist with medical care if permitted by the Captain on duty
- If you see ANYTHING that bothers you, are unsure of, ask a Fire Officer (Preferably a Captain)
- Ride-A-Long waiver letters must be completely filled out prior to each Ride-A-Long





General Organization

Command Structure

Advisors- Will use their education in the Fire Science and EMS to help educate Explorers

Explorer Captain- Will head the Explorer Post and help run post meeting

Explorer Lieutenants- 1 or 2, He/She will have the responsibility of taking attendance, recruiting, and contacting Explorers about meeting changes, etc.

Explorers and Probationary Explorers- Help assist in training set up; be on time; be ready to learn; and have FUN

Promotion

Lieutenant

- A. Must have been a Post member for at least one year
- B. Must complete an essay on why they want to be an Explorer Lieutenant
- C. Must complete an Explorer promotional interview
- D. The Explorer Captain and/or Advisors can appoint a new Lieutenant even if the applicant doesn't meet the one year requirement

Captain

- A. Must have been a Lieutenant for at least one year
- B. Must complete an interview with the Past Captain and Advisor
- C. Must be at least 16 years old

• Navy Explorer T-Shirt

- Black Shoes or Boots
- Navy Job-Shirt (optional)

• Navy EMS Pants





Code of Conduct

- 1. Have Fun!
- 2. Be Safe
- 3. Use Common Sense
- 4. Be respectful
- 5. Stay out of Living Quarters, Dispatch, and Offices
- 6. No use of Alcohol or Illegal Drugs during any Explorer functions
- 7. NO Sexual Harassment will be tolerated
- 8. Maintain GPA of 2.0
- 9. No Horse Play
- 10. Be well groomed, keep hair tied back, and take pride in your self
- 11. Any Explorer accused of stealing by the public or in the station may be subject to Police investigation
- 12. If you sign up for an event be there
- 13. What you hear at the station stays at the station; any violation is subject to dismissal from the post
- 14. Have your chapter read each week and be prepared to learn

<u>Bunker Gear</u>

- A. You are responsible for your gear
- B. Keep bunker gear clean
- C. Gear must be kept at Station 2 unless signed out and you have permission from an Advisor
